Asbestos Policy

Introduction

This document brings our asbestos policy regarding asbestos into line with the requirements of the control of asbestos at work regulations which were revised in November 2006

Responsibilities

CT Construction Limited policy on asbestos intends to ensure so far as it is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare at work of its employees and others who may encounter or be exposed to asbestos.

CT Construction Limited policy on asbestos shall ensure that known and identified locations of asbestos are recorded and that any such asbestos information is made available to those persons who require it.

Directors are responsible, so far as is reasonably practicable, for ensuring the health, safety, and welfare at work of all employees in their respective departments. They will:
Prepare and revise as necessary department arrangements for the management and control of work involving asbestos.

Ensure appropriate training, information and instruction is provided for relevant employees, and personal instructions appropriate.

Ensure that employees or relevant contractors are provided with appropriate information, regarding company procedures in areas containing Asbestos.

Precautions

Prior to commencement of works to a previously developed site, or works of a demolition or refurbishment nature, the Contracts Manager must liaise with the Client, Safety, Health & Environmental team or specialist contractors to ensure an appropriate survey is undertaken to ascertain if any asbestos-based materials are present. Any suspicious materials will be sampled and sent for analysis.

Training

Information, toolbox talks, instruction will be given to all employees and other persons affected, relevant to the specific project including:

- CT Construction will ensure that all employees receive asbestos awareness training were relevant to their duties
- The health risks associated with asbestos
- Reporting procedures
- Their responsibilities
- Emergency Procedures
- All Sub-contractors will provide evidence of asbestos awareness training.

Based upon the analysis report an assessment will be made by a specialist contractor as to the best method to prevent exposure to asbestos fibres.

In all cases this will involve the use of specialist contractors with a license issued by the HSE for the removal of asbestos containing materials. A copy of the contractor license must be provided to the site management before work starts.

Before any asbestos related works proceed a licensed contractor must produce a written method statement for approval by the CT Construction site team, approval will be given in writing. The method statement will include control measures as appropriate for the type of asbestos work being undertaken.

The method statement must include the following details as a minimum:

- Type of asbestos
- Method of removal
- Anticipated fibre release
- Control measures to minimise the release of fibre
- Plan of works to include details of enclosures, viewing panels, NPU's, bag locks, transit routes waste bin and de-contamination unit, as appropriate for the work being undertaken.
- Testing of enclosure (smoke testing will be witnesses)
- Emergency procedures

Decontamination procedures

- Respiratory protective equipment (RPE) and personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Air monitoring arrangements
- Removal of waste
- Copies of consignment notes
- Clearance certificates

If the asbestos survey identifies that the material to be removed is a notifiable Asbestos Containing Material, the 'Licensed Contractor' will be required to give 14 days prior notice of the work starting to the HSE. CT Construction Limited project team will require the notification form ASB5 before work proceeds.
